Notebooks and pencils are treasures for families who struggle to afford basic school supplies. School kits often are requested after disasters and help bring normalcy to children whose families have been forced to flee their homes. Last year, 70,652 were shipped to Jordan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Canada, Ethiopia, Iraq, Democratic Republic of Korea (North Korea), the U.S., Serbia and more.
