Progress on the new facilities manager house at Camp CAMREC has continued late winter and presses on. We estimate that we will need \$50,000 to complete the work. This assumes that volunteers will provide labor for remaining tasks. To date we have covered all costs through donations and a \$75,000 loan from our endowment fund. So, fundraising must continue, and volunteers need to show up. Please consider how you can assist us in finishing the final stretch of this project.
